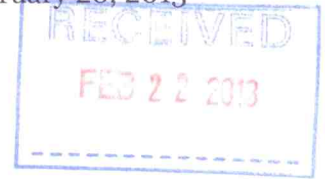

It is with great pleasure that Judith and I announce that CG Labs, Inc. is now accredited by the ASCLD-LAB International program in the field of Human Performance Forensic Toxicology (Blood/Alcohol only). This accreditation also encompasses the International ISO-17025 requirements for a testing laboratory.

I know of only three other independent laboratories in the country that are accredited to perform alcohol testing on blood and only two of them hold an ISO-17025 accreditation. **None** hold the ASCLD-LAB International accreditation. Perhaps this is why the team that evaluated us was "stunned" to find only 4 nonconformances of the 500+ requirements. These 4 nonconformances were corrected prior to the issuance of the accreditation.

Sadly, everything comes with a price. The accreditation process costs time and money to obtain and maintain. Some of this additional cost is reflected in our new prices effective April 1, 2013. Only the analysis fees have increased. The complete and current price list is displayed on our web page. The new analysis fees are:

Analysis of Breath Capture tubes:	\$160
Analysis of blood for alcohol:	\$125

Also note that the laboratory will be closed from February 22 to March 11, 2013. It would be preferable that blood samples not be sent during this time period. Neither Judith nor I will be available for consultation during this period.

I would also like to know if there is any interest in having a "GC day with Jay" professional development workshop.
