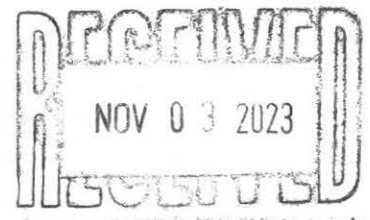
I don't know how they do it — especially young single mothers — but somehow so many of them rise to meet these brutal challenges and more.”
